LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT DEPUTY CHIEF DONALD GRAHAM

"I love that Filipinos love to be in places where they can serve, where they can make people's lives better. That's part of the Filipino heart, it's about service."

--LAPD Deputy Chief Don Graham, (First LAPD chief officer of Filipino descent) Deputy Chief Donald Graham is the highest ranking Filipino-American officer at the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD). In this inaugural issue of Balita, Chief Graham shares his love of Los Angeles and how being a Filipino American has shaped his identity.

"The Filipino heart is divided into three sections: food, service and family. That's our identity and being able to experience that in LA has been a tremendous uplift into my understanding of my own heritage."

Chief Graham grew up in the predominantly white suburb of Bayonne, New Jersey, where his family would have to drive three hours to visit family for a taste of Filipino culture.

"We were the only Filipino family at my school in Bayonne, New Jersey. Kids in the school yard would say, "What kind of Chinese are you?"

At age 14, his parents divorced and the family moved to LA. It was love at first sight.

Chief Graham appreciated the cosmopolitan nature of the City and its embrace of all cultures.

Living and working in LA taught Chief Graham that diversity is "About understanding. The more diversity, the more we can connect with all races and colors that live in our city."

Today, Chief Graham commands the LAPD Transit Services Bureau, where he oversees the City's four traffic divisions. These officers and civilian partners are responsible for traffic education, traffic enforcement, street racing enforcement, and the fleet safety of the Los Angeles Police Department.

He also oversees the Transit Services Group, which provides policing services to the trains, buses, shuttles, stations, and platforms of the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transit Authority (MTA) system within the City of Los Angeles.

It wasn't until he reached the rank of Lieutenant in 2012 that he realized that other Filipino Americans looked up to him as an example.

"Knowing unintentionally that I've had that impact, that's shaped how I've looked at my responsibility in this trailblazing position. I have that responsibility to demonstrate that it's not a one-off, everybody has an opportunity. I've been blessed my whole career."

A meeting with Philippine Consul General Edgar Badajos


